Lochside Theatre Booking Conditions

(November 1997)

Theatrical Performance

1. Any change of performance, title or cast, or cancellation of performance must be agreed in writing with Lochside Theatre.
2. In order to comply with fire regulations:
 - scenery and stage properties must be treated with fire retardant.
 - prior notification is required if pyrotechnics or lasers are to be used in any performance.

Warning - Failure by the Hirer to comply with this requirement will be regarded as a material breach of contract. In such an event, Lochside Theatre will cancel the performance, with full hire charges and any resultant expenses payable by the Hirer.
3. Lochside Theatre's permanent equipment, ie lighting control boards, sound system etc may only be operated with the permission of Lochside Theatre technicians.
4. If you provide your own Lighting / Sound Crew then they must be suitably qualified and acceptable to the theatre's technical staff. Supporting technical staff, if required, will be available from 6.00pm on the evening of the performance, or as specifically arranged in writing with Lochside Theatre and the specific technical staff involved.
5. Where appropriate, the Hirer will provide details to enable Lochside Theatre to make its returns to the Performing Rights Society.

General Conditions

6. Although Lochside Theatre has general insurance cover on persons and goods, Hirers are advised to arrange their own cover for the performance and any specific items. Lochside Theatre cannot accept responsibility for any items or possessions left unattended in the Theatre.
7. The Hirer shall be liable for the cost of any repair to or replacement of items or building fabric or structure necessitated through the negligent acts or omissions of the Hirer or its members. It is expressly stated that no part of the fee payable to Lochside Theatre applies to the provision of insurance cover for the Hirer or its artists or members.
8. Lochside Theatre shall not be responsible to the Hirer for any loss incurred by the Hirer as a result of the failure or faulty operation of the said equipment or other stage or theatre installations.
9. The Hirer will leave the theatre, dressing rooms, foyer and all other areas of the building clean and tidy. An additional charge will be made where special cleaning is required.
